RE: EC Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS) and 2002/96/EC (WEEE)

Thank you for your recent enquiry concerning the Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS) and Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directives.

Mode Lighting design, manufacture and market products that meet or exceed the demanding and ever changing requirements of today's lighting industry using the highest quality components and construction techniques.

We have pleasure to confirm compliance with the RoHS and WEEE Directives, as follows:

RoHS	1st July 2006	Products RoHS compliant – hazardous substances banned
WEEE	1 st April 2007	Products fall outside the scope of the WEEE Directive

The exemption is specified in the WEEE Regulations UK Government Guidance Notes to SI 2006 No. 3289, dated February 2007 (URN07/619), paragraph 25, 30 and 31:

25. The WEEE Directive provides for a number of exemptions from its provisions for a broad range of products and equipment. These exemptions are reflected in the UK WEEE Regulations.
30. Equipment may also be part of a fixed installation. A "fixed installation" may be a combination of several pieces of equipment, systems, products and/or components (or parts) assembled and/or erected by a professional assembler or installer at a given place to operate together in an expected environment and to perform a specific task, but not intended to be placed on the market as a single functional or commercial unit.
31. In such a case, the elements of a system that are not discernible Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) products in their own right or that do not have a direct function away from the installation are considered to be excluded from the scope of the Regulations.
